Background:

A growing, research-intensive university

Established in 1920, Swansea University is a research-led university with a long history of working with business and industry. The University's research changes lives, drives innovation and regional growth, and is aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals. One of Swansea University's strategic goals is to continue to increase its research profile and funding capture across a range of providers. But trying to keep up to date with the volume of updates regarding funders and schemes that come and go can be a daunting task. As such, the University is focused on diversifying its portfolio of funders to ensure that it is not over-reliant on any particular funding stream.
